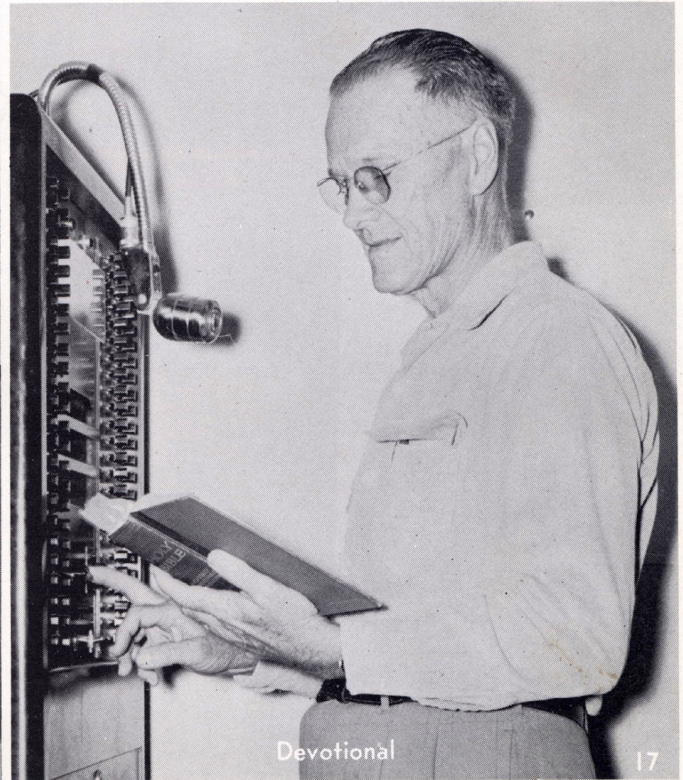


Announcements

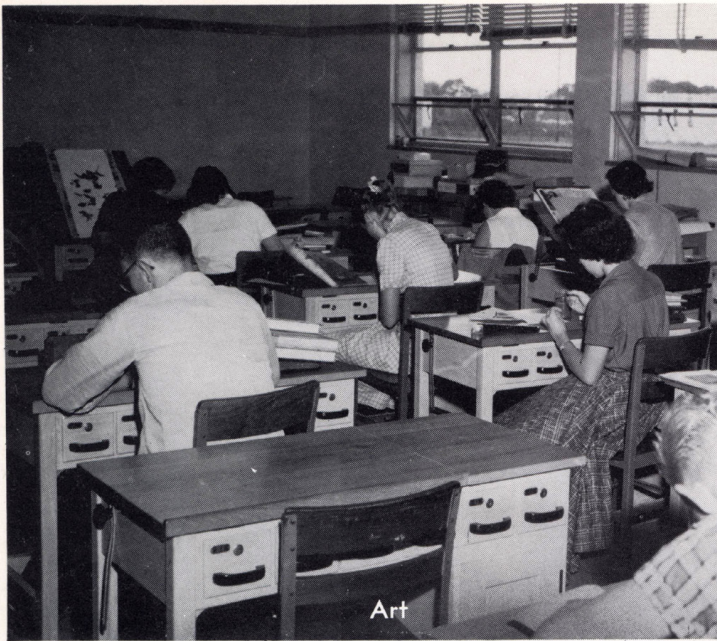

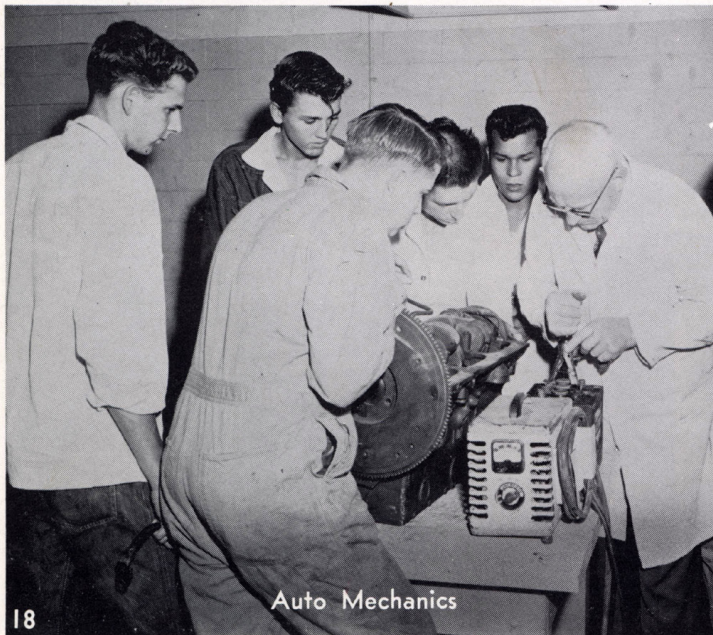


Home Economics

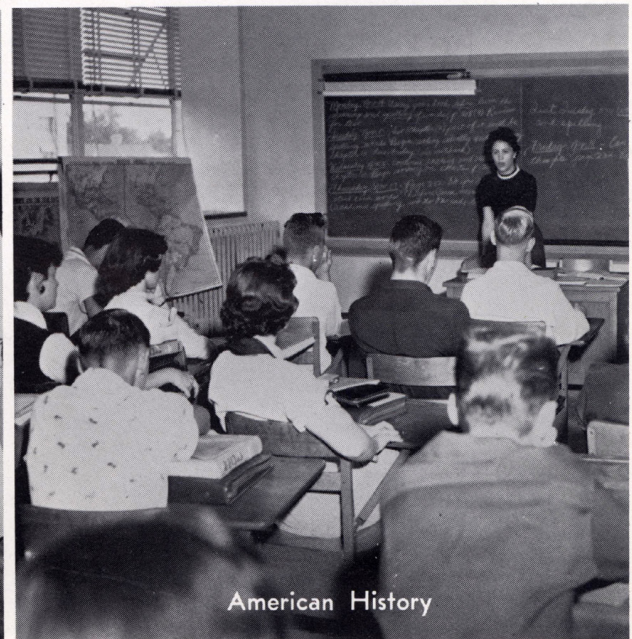


Typing

Lunch Time



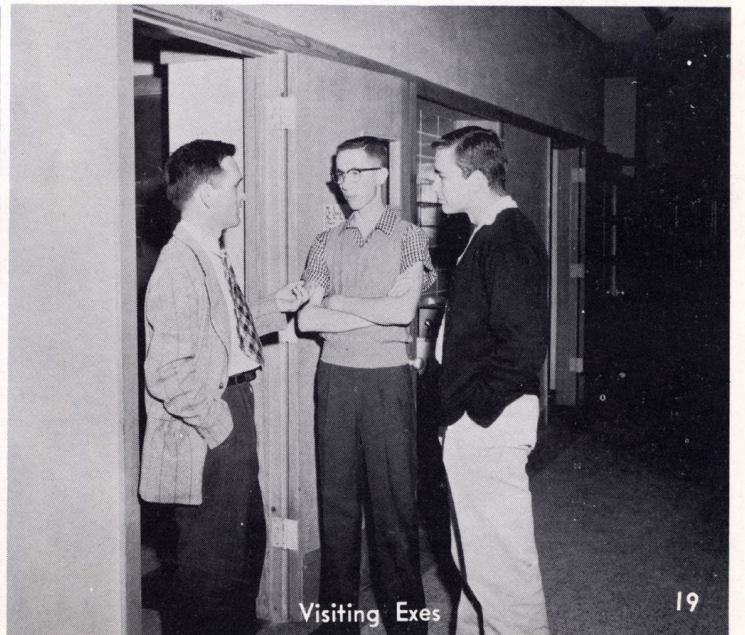

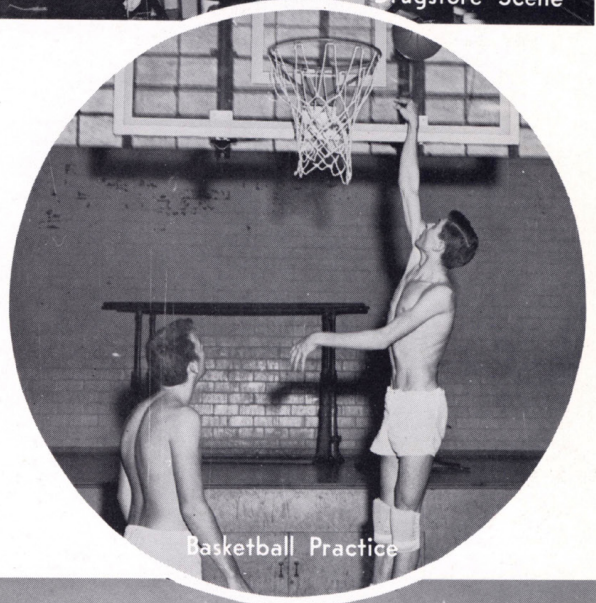
School's Out

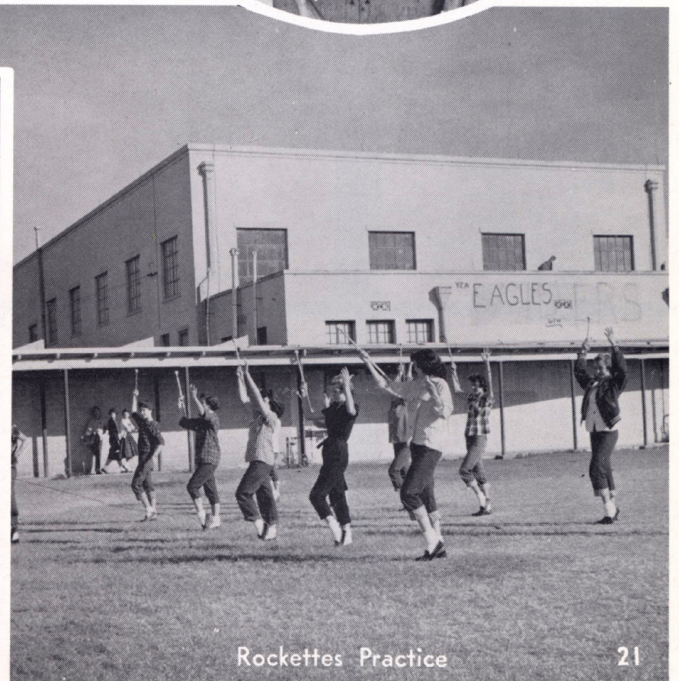
The Rockettes and the PHS Band also put in long hard hours of practice after school. And there are some students who like school so well that they find other excuses for staying . . . detention hall.
