

## Pasadena High School 2015-2016 Parking Permits

- 1. Parking permits are issued to <u>seniors first</u>. If spaces are still available, they will then be available to juniors, then sophomores.
- 2. Freshman are not allowed to park on campus.
- 3. <u>Permits are \$30 for the year.</u> We do not sell one semester at a time. Parking tags (stickers) will be placed on the vehicle's front windshield.
- 4. Lost permits will only be replaced by permission of the campus administration.
- 5. All students less than 18 years of age must provide a parent signed application. All applicants must provide a Texas Driver's License and a copy of the insurance card with the student's name and vehicle information.
- 6. Parking in restricted areas such as teacher or administrator areas will result in disciplinary action.
- 7. The speed limit while on the parking lot is 5 mph and should not be exceeded.
- 8. If the driving of, or the presence of, an automobile causes any discipline problem(s) or is deemed "unsafe", a student may forfeit the privilege of parking on Pasadena High School's campus.
- 9. Students may only use parking spots with **WHITE lines** and they must be legally parked between the lines.
- 10. All vehicles parking on school property are under the control of the school or district policies and regulations, which include the right to search the vehicle. (See page 30 of Student Handbook)
