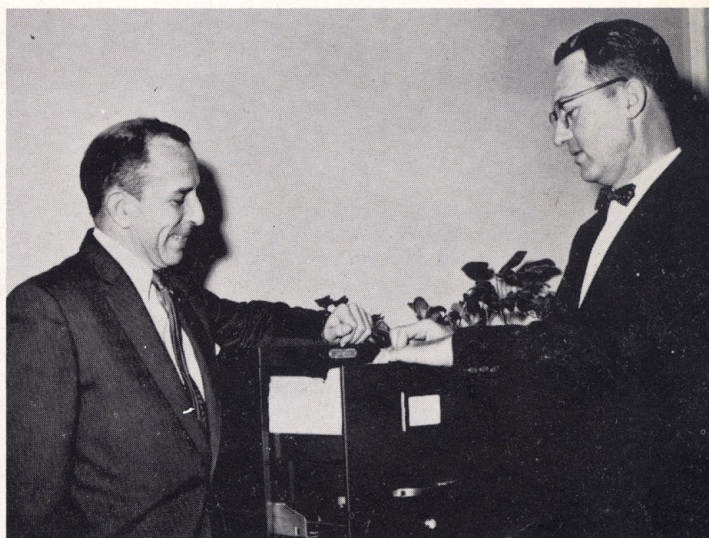

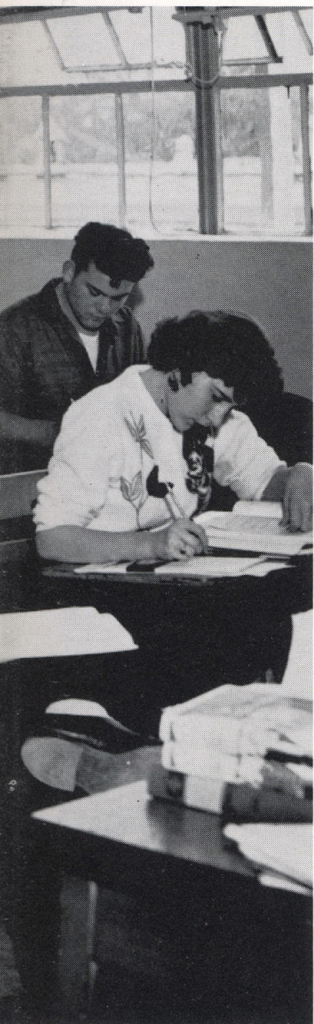

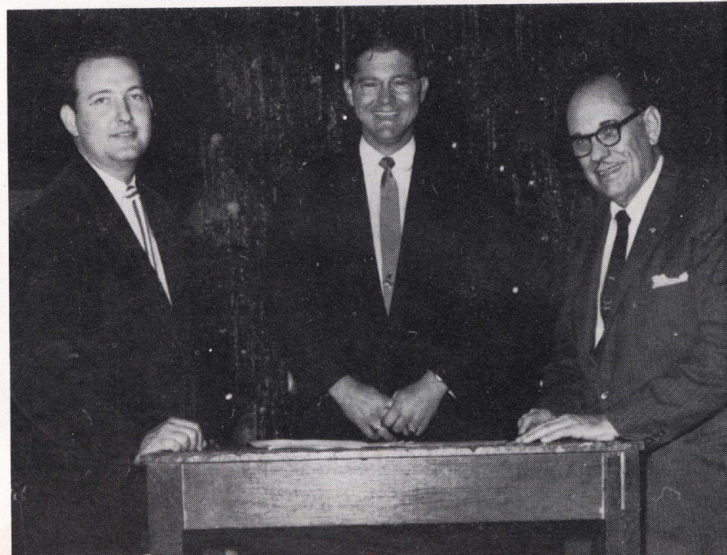

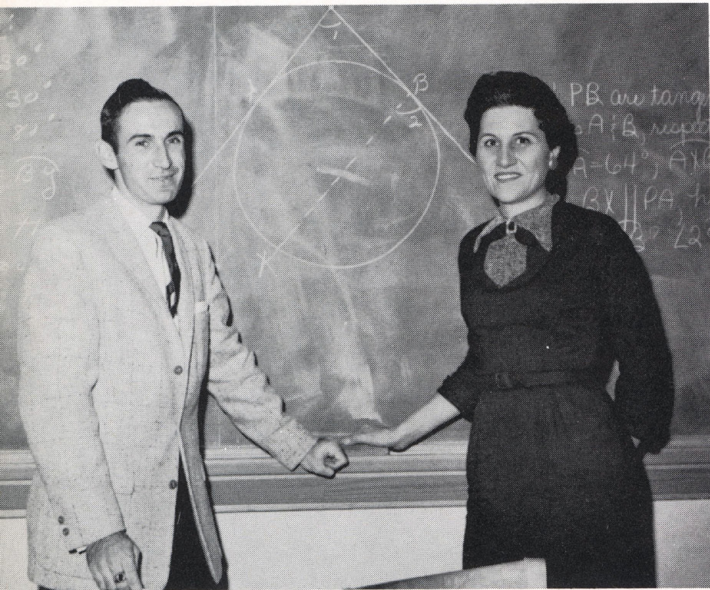

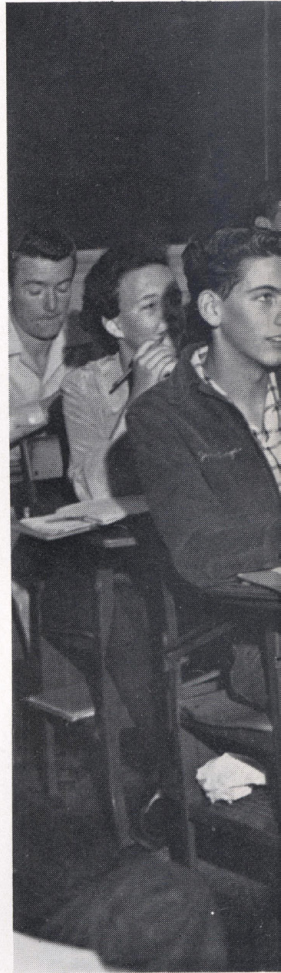

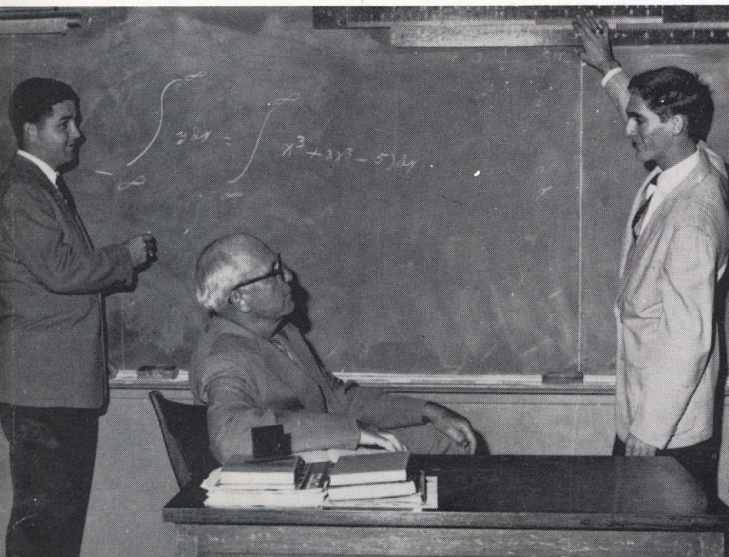


# KEEP US MENTALLY ALERT

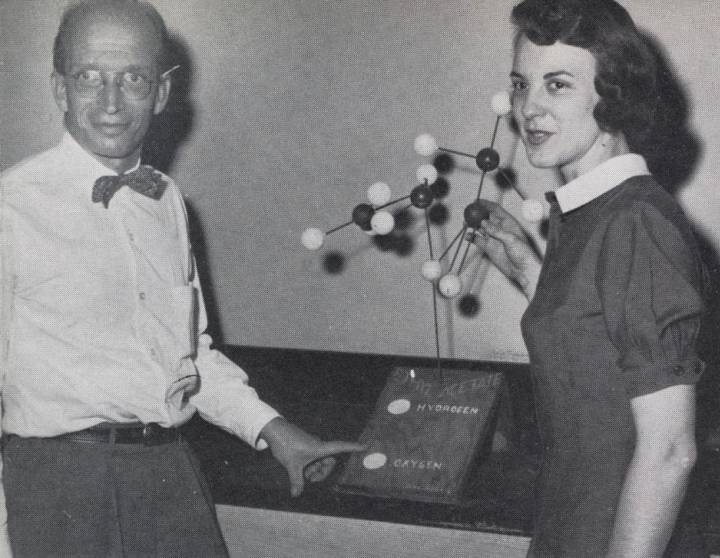

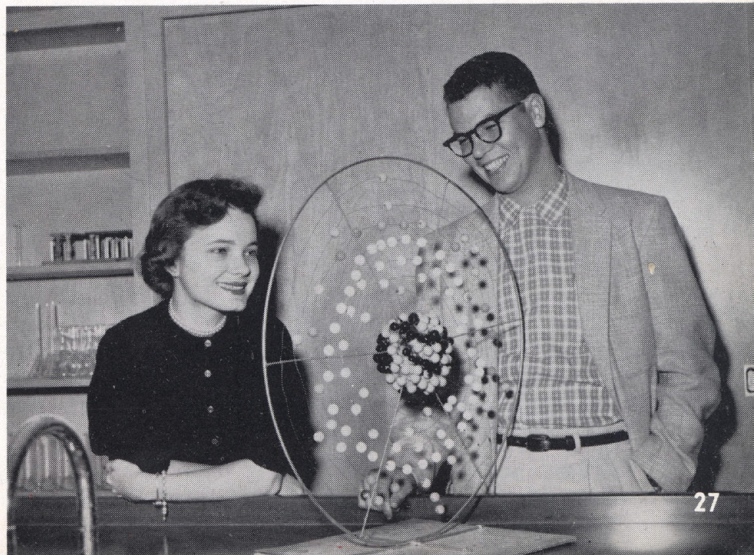

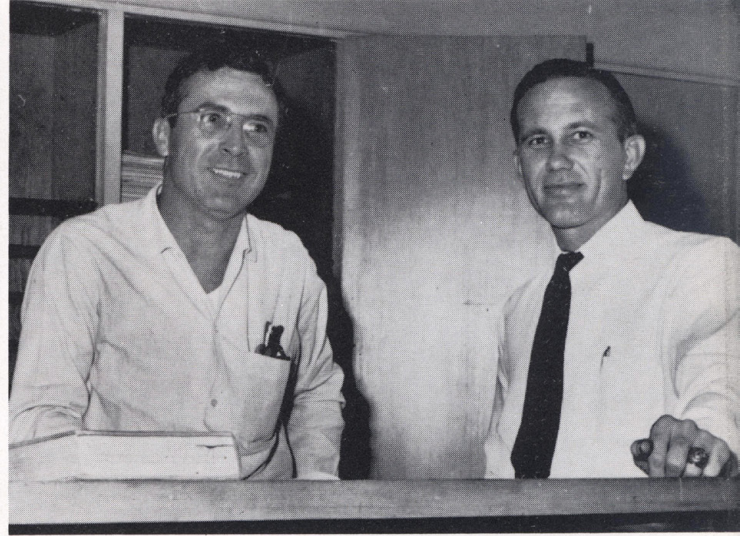

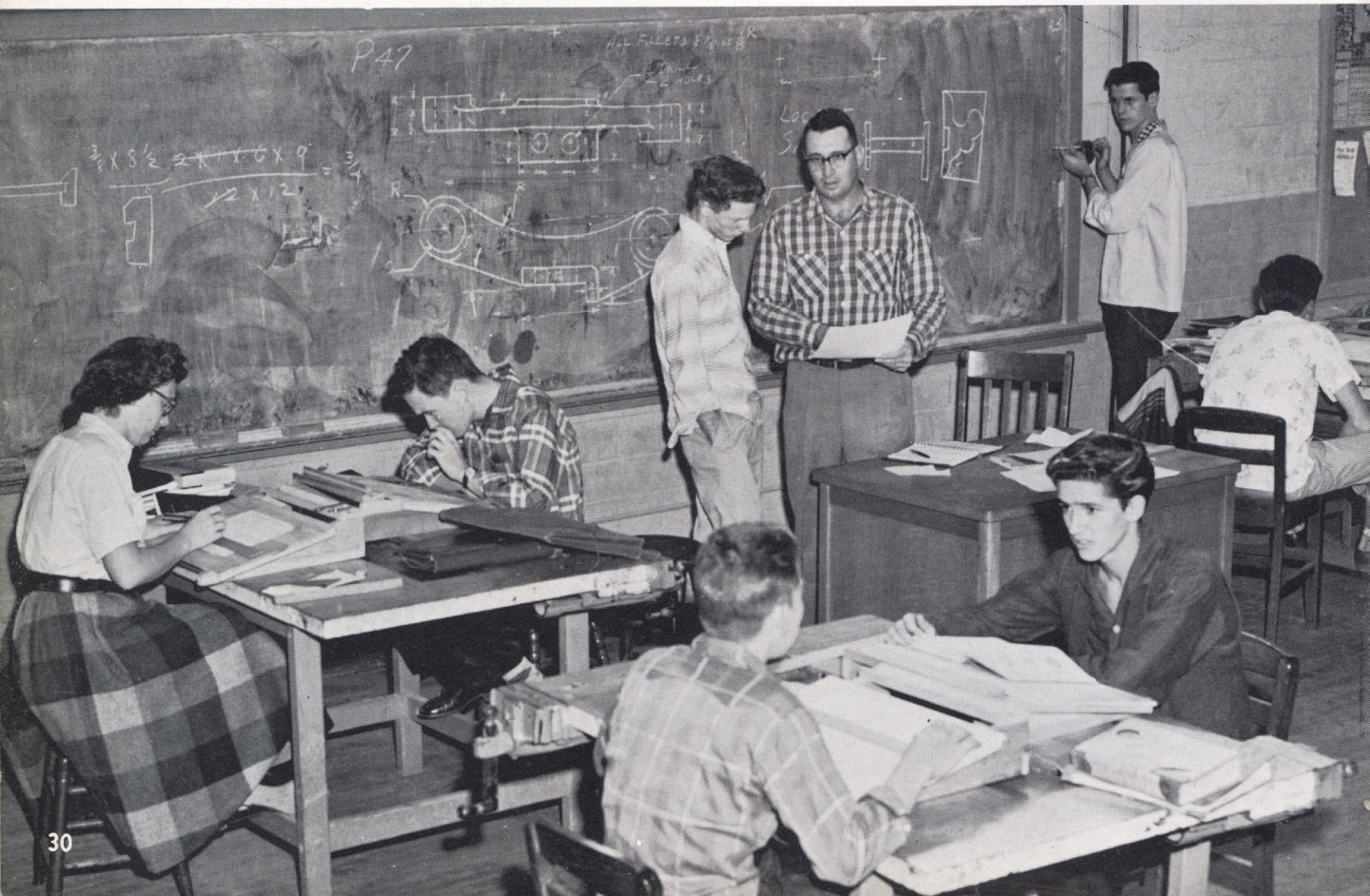

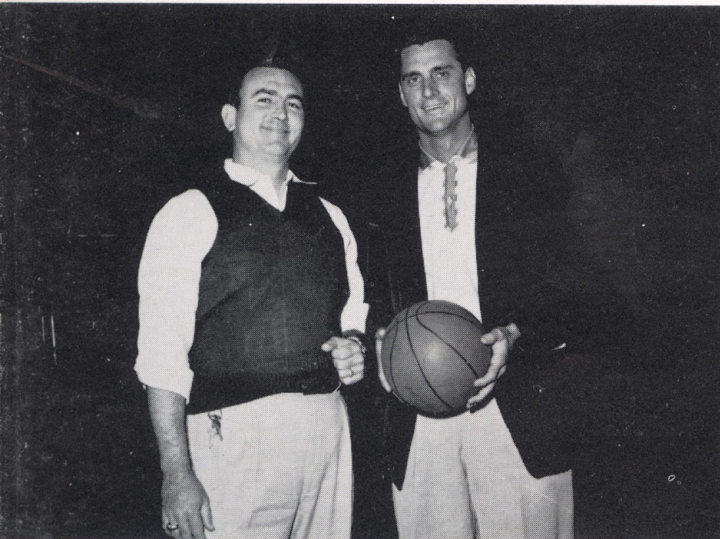
