The "P" has been used throughout the book to depict the various activities of school life.

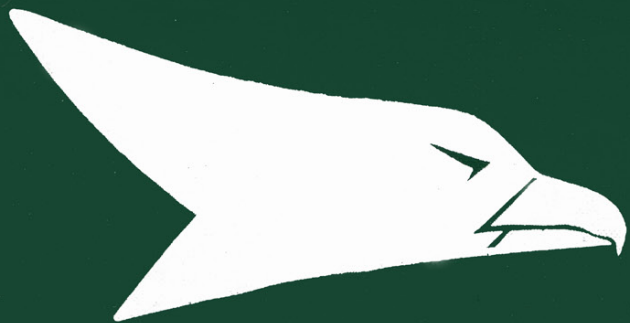
This book could not have been produced without the help of the student body, faculty, and the hard work of a wonderful staff and sponsor. My thanks go to all of these.
