Finally, it is the sincere wish of the entire STATESMAN staff that each student will derive hours of pleasure from the reading of this book.

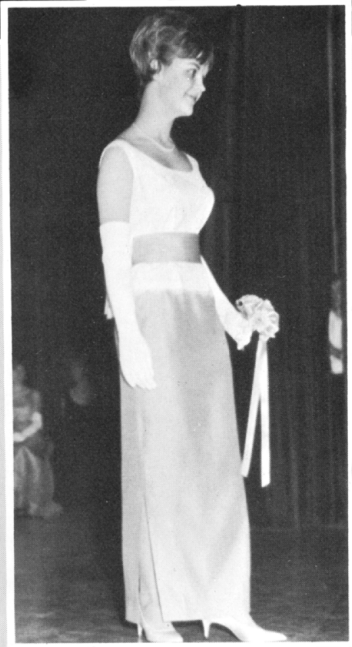
